Special Issue: Young and emerging scholars' research in co-operative studies

Submission Deadline: 31 August 2014

The International Co-operative Alliance Committee on Co-operative Research (CCR) invites new and upcoming scholars – currently studying or within two years after graduation – in co-operative studies and/or co-operative business to submit their research papers to be considered for publication in the <u>peer-reviewed</u> 2014 edition of the *Review of International Co-operation* dedicated to young scholars. Papers must present new research and cannot be already published in academic journals or working papers. Co-authored papers will be accepted.

This special issue of the *Review* will showcase multi-disciplinary research of the emerging scholars in co-operative enterprises and co-operative studies more generally.

Note: Papers already submitted by young and emerging scholars for the special edition of the *Journal of Co-operative Management and Organization* on 'Co-operatives in local and regional development' in conjunction with the CCR 2014 research conference in Pula, Croatia will automatically be considered for the special edition of the *Review*.

Best Paper Awards: Papers by young and emerging scholars accepted for publication in EITHER the Special edition of the *Journal of Co-operative Management and Organization* OR the *Review of International Co-operation* will be adjudicated by the reviewers; the top three papers will be awarded prizes as follows:

- 1st Place 500 Euros
- 2nd Place 300 Euros
- 3rd Place 200 Euros
